THEME: PUBLIC POLICY MAKING PROCESS and the "BIG FOUR" AGENDA

KIPPRA in collaboration with Maasai Mara University is organizing the KIPPRA Mentorship Program for Universities (KMPUs). The event will take place on the 16th November 2018, at Maasai Mara University. The program targets to bring together university students, lecturers, government and private sector.

The theme of the event will be "Public Policy Process and the Big Four Agenda". Maasai Mara University students are invited to submit concept papers around this thematic area, consisting of no more than 300 words. The submissions should focus on any of the four areas of the agenda: Food security, Manufacturing (Job creation), Affordable Universal Health Care and Affordable housing and should address the following questions: What is your understanding of the 'Big Four' Agenda? What do you think it will take to achieve it? and where do you see yourself playing a role?

The deadline for submission of concept papers is 30th October 2018, after which they will undergo a review process. Successful applicants shall be notified of the acceptance of their proposals and participation in the panel discussion during the KMPUs event. The students shall also be invited to participate in an essay writing competition. Certificate of participation shall also be awarded to the successful students.
