### **SUBJECT: PROVISION OF HEALTH SERVICES**

Following my earlier communication on the above subject, the University Medical Officer wishes to advise students of the available options for registering with NHIF:

#### **1. OPTION A**

- (i) Individual students visit any NHIF branch in Kenya with a copy of their National Identification Card for registration.
- (ii) For those under 18 years of age, the Principal member (parent/guardian) should ensure that the specific dependant/student selects **Maasai Mara University (Narok University Medical Centre) NHIF H. Code 00031164** as their preferred outpatient centre.
- (iii) A monthly fee of Ksh.500 is charged for the cost of health care service by NHIF, students should pay a minimum of **Ksh.3,500** (three thousand five hundred only) equivalent to seven months (to cover for two semesters). This can be paid through Mpesa, details to be provided by NHIF after registration.
- (iv) Students should ensure that they select **Maasai Mara University (Narok University Medical Centre) NHIF H. Code 00031164** as their preferred outpatient centre.

## 2. OPTION B

- (i) On admission date, the NHIF officials from Narok branch shall be available at the health department to register the individual student. A copy of the National Identification Card is required for registration.
- (ii) Conditions (ii), (iii), (iv) above shall apply.
- (iii) No student shall be admitted without NHIF cards.
