SUBJECT: PROVISION OF HEALTH SERVICES TO STUDENTS – REMINDER

Reference is made to the memos dated 12th April 2018 and 27th April 2018 on the above mentioned subject.

As indicated in the memos, all students were expected to register with the National Hospital Insurance Fund (NHIF) before the commencement of the September – December 2018 semester and present copies of the NHIF card on the reporting date. Students who have not complied with this requirement are therefore advised to do so before the end of the registration period on **Friday, 21st September 2018** to avoid any sanctions. Please take note of the registration procedure as follows:

- (i) Individual students should visit any NHIF branch in Kenya with a copy of their National Identification Card for registration.
- (ii) For those under 18 years of age, the Principal member (parent/guardian) should ensure that the specific dependant/student selects **Maasai Mara University (Narok University Medical Centre) NHIF H. Code 00031164** as their preferred outpatient centre.
- (iii) A monthly fee of Ksh.500 is charged for the cost of health care service by NHIF, students should pay a minimum of **Ksh.3,500** (three thousand five hundred only) equivalent to seven months (to cover for two semesters). This can be paid through Mpesa, details to be provided by NHIF after registration.
- (iv) Students should ensure that they select Maasai Mara University (**Narok University Medical Centre**) NHIF H. Code **00031164** as their preferred outpatient centre.
