SUBJECT: PROVISION OF HEALTH SERVICES

The University has considered the need to provide quality and equitable health services to its students, taking into account the government health policy that encourages progression towards Universal Health Coverage.

Currently, students pay a standard fee for health care services offered within the University. This means they have to seek for alternative health care when on off campus activities like teaching practice, attachments etc.

In order to improve on the provision of quality health services by the University and expand the domain of existing health care arrangement, it has been decided that from the May to August 2018 semester, students should register with the National Hospital Insurance Fund (NHIF). The University will consequently suspend the medical fee paid by students at the beginning of every academic year so that they can register with NHIF.
