SUBJECT: PROVISION OF HEALTH SERVICES TO STUDENTS

This is to inform you that starting from September 2018, the University will cease charging medical fee of Kshs. 3000 as indicated in the revised fee structure also attached. Instead, students will be required to register with the National Hospital Insurance Fund (NHIF). The University has provided two options for registration with NHIF as follows:

1. Option A:

- i) For students below 25 years of age, the Principal member (parent/guardian) should register with any NHIF branch countrywide before the reporting date and select **Maasai Mara University (Narok University Medical Centre) NHIF Hospital Code 00031164** as the **student's** preferred outpatient centre.
- ii) Students above 25 years are expected to register with NHIF individually.

Students will be required to present a copy of the NHIF card on the reporting date

2. Options B:

The Principal member (parent/guardian) may opt to register with NHIF at the University on the reporting date. A copy of the parent's/guardian's national Identity card and Students national ID/birth certificate will be required for registration. Additionally, the parent/guardian will be required to pay Kshs. 6,000 to NHIF on the date of registration through M-pesa. The paybill number will be provided during the registration process.

Please note that students will not be cleared to attend classes without an up to date NHIF subscription. For students who might have already paid the medical fee, the payment will go towards the subsequent semester's fee.
