2. What are the admission requirements for the Masters programmes?

Answer: Candidates must possess:

A second-class honors degree (upper division) in relevant fields such as Environmental Studies, Geography, or related areas from a recognized university.

Alternatively, a second-class honors degree (lower division) may be accepted with a minimum of two years of relevant professional experience.

3. What is the duration of the Masters programmes?

Answer: The Master's programmes typically take two years of full-time study to complete.

4. What is the structure of the Master's programmes?

Answer: Generally, the programmes consist of:

Core coursework in the first year.

Specialized courses in the second semester.

A research thesis in the second year.

5. Is there an application fee for the graduate programmes?

Answer: Yes, the application fee is Kshs. 2000.

6. How do I apply for the graduate programmes?
